

ENZCon'05 Report

ENZCon'05 was held at Manukau Institute of Technology for the first time on Monday 14 and Tuesday 15 November.

The convener of the conference was Len Jennings and all conference events except the conference dinner were in the one building (PBlock). The conference attracted participants from tertiary institutions from all over New Zealand. There was an equal number of student and full registrations. A total of 62 attendees registered and 40 papers were presented.

The student registrations were subsidised by the full registrations. The conference financially broke even with the Electrical and Computer Engineering department at MIT sponsoring the student prizes and paying for miscellaneous conference costs.

There were a large number of very good student papers. The student prize winners were(\$250 for each paper): Hugo Vincent and John Stowers from University of Canterbury for their paper: "Practical Considerations for Implementation of an Unmanned Aerial Vehicle (UAV)" and Praneel Chand from Waikato University for his paper: "Reactive Control of a Tricycle Mobile Robot".
